
### Introduction



1. On the ABS home page, click on the **Statistics** tab.




2. Select a topic, e.g. Housing.




3. Select a sub-topic, e.g. Homelessness.



4. Review the data in the **Key Findings**. If you need more specific information, click **List of Tables** to review the contents of the downloadable data cubes.




5. Click on **Downloads** to select relevant data cubes.
