Procedure

1. From your list of search results, click the star icon underneath any result.



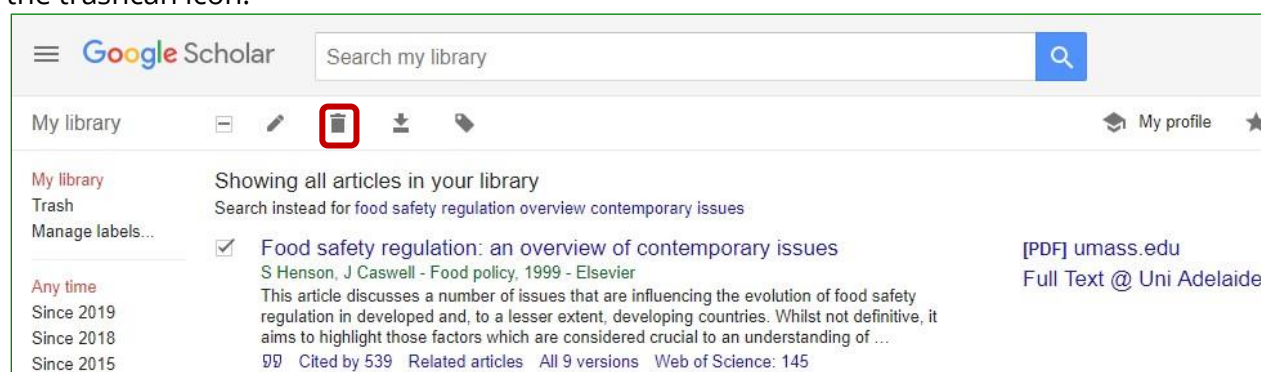
